Dear Friends in Christ,

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King and we acknowledge his sovereignty over heaven and earth. So, what exactly does it mean when we hear that Christ is King? As we hear in the Gospel and from St. Paul, when Jesus comes again, he will sit in judgment over all things. It is he who will take the whole of creation and present it to the Father after doing away with sin and death. On that day, he will make us worthy to present to the Father. On that day, all who are faithful shall reign with him in the Kingdom of Heaven. Let us then prepare ourselves for the coming day of the Lord when his kingship is revealed and set firm always and everywhere.

We have been using the new translation of the Roman Missal for several weeks now and I hope you are feeling more comfortable with it. I am very pleased with how well the church has done with the changes in the responses. There are two points that could use some practice. When the priest or deacon says to us, "The Lord be with you" our response is always, "and with your spirit". The second that could use some practice is during the preface dialogue. When the priest says, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God" the response is, "It is right and just." Keep working on it and we'll have it down in no time at all.

I also have a couple of invitations for you. The first is for Mass on Thanksgiving Day. Mass will be at 9:00 am and I encourage you to bring some food from your Thanksgiving table to the church. You can place it in the sanctuary before the start of Mass and I'll bless it for you before you take it home. The second invitation is for the St. Charles Christmas Party December 17th at the Anchors and Spurs. It is a wonderful event and a time for some well-deserved enjoyment of good friends, good food, and live entertainment. Please join us! Tickets are available in front of the Church after the morning Masses today.
