- To prevent inbreeding, the government will trade off the Billy every two years to three years.

**Father's House Christian School
and Home**

- Goats will provide fresh milk for the students and orphans and staff
- Each goat produces about 1.5 liters of milk per day. Currently, 2 of the goats are milking; 3 are pregnant, and 3 are not yet mature enough for breeding.
- Goats are bred yearly, and the offspring can be sold to assist in making the Home and School self-sufficient.
