Meeting place outside room 13. We carpool to the border and chip in \$8 per car for parking (\$2 each). The nuns will pick us up at the Mexican side of San Ysidro border. We may be back about 2:00 pm in San Diego.

**Nov. 19 & 20, Saturday & Sunday will be the Caritas Day.** 100% of your donations will go to buy basic food, cleaning products and basic necessities for the 9 charities.
