When we arrived at the dump site La Esperanza Clinic, it was **not** raining. 20 minutes after we gave these items, and all the people were back to their homes, then the rain fell all the way to San Diego.

It was pouring rain last Saturday morning when we left San Diego to go to the TJ dump site to distribute the bags of food, tubes of tooth paste, goodies for children, crackers/cookies, raisins and blankets to more than 250 poor families living around the dump site area. The people waited from 4:00 am and we arrived at 9:30am. We came back to San Diego around 12:30pm. Not only the 250 poor families received the food but also the people without tickets were able to get some food.

Since we had a limited number of blankets, these went to selected people: mothers carrying their babies, pregnant women and also elderly people.
