Daily Prayer For Priests

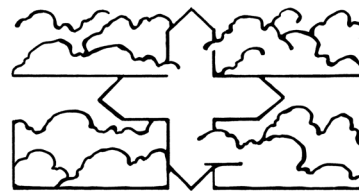

The Feast of Divine Mercy



Today, April 28th, is the Feast of Divine Mercy.

Come join your fellow parishioners for the Feast of Divine Mercy, after the 1:00 PM Mass. We will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, followed by inspirational readings, benediction, and blessing of the images.

Jesus said to St. Faustina: "I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: "Jesus I Trust in You". (Diary of St. Faustina, 327)

"The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment . . . Let no soul fear to draw near to me, even though its sins be as scarlet. . . mankind will have no peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy." (Diary 699)

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Divine Mercy for the faithful who are in a state of grace, to confess all serious sins through the Sacrament of Penance, to receive Communion and to pray for the Holy Father's intentions by reciting the Lord's Prayer, the Apostle's Creed, and end with the Ejaculation, "Merciful Jesus, I trust in You."

En el libro del Apocalipsis, “nuestro hermano Juan” no solo afirma que vio vivo a Jesús, sino que transmite las palabras de Jesús que dan vida: “¡No tengan miedo!” ¡Ver a Jesús en los demás es creer!

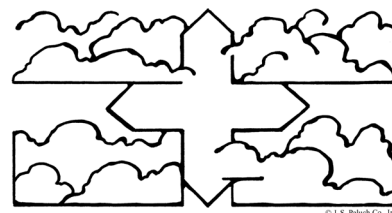
