THIS IS THE HOLY TRINITY

Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity, one of the most confounding mysteries of our faith. Through this mystery we experience our relationship to God: Creator, Savior, and Holy Spirit. This relationship is not easy to understand or to describe. It does not become clearer through analysis. Its complexity mirrors the complexity of all our relationships. We understand our relationships with our spouses, our children, our parents, and our friends only through daily give-and-take, annual rituals, and the life-changing moments we share. We understand our relationships only as we live them. The relationships we have with those we love, and who love us, sustain us

through an uncertain and difficult life. This is the Holy Trinity.

What is striking about today's readings is that each is incomplete. What they do offer is a description of a moment in our relationship, a memory of a time and an event when our relationship made sense even though that sense may be beyond our ability to describe fully. Often that is all that our faith offers, that is, a memory of what is possible, what is promised, what has been given. A memory of eternity, of love beyond understanding is to be cherished and nurtured even if not fully understood. This is the Holy Trinity.

Requirements for enrollment:

- ◆ Provide a copy of the Certificate of Baptism of the student.
- ◆ Complete a registration form (available at the Catechetical Ministry Center or on the website).
- ◆ Schedule an interview with the Director of Catechetical Ministry or the Youth Minister.

Registration fee is due at the time of enrollment which can be paid in cash, check, or credit card:

- ◆ \$80 for one child
- ◆ \$140 for two children
- ◆ \$200 for three children
- ◆ \$260 for four children
- ◆ Plus: \$200 Retreat Fee for **Confirmation II ONLY**

The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette will preach the annual parish mission appeal.

Having brought the fullness of Life to our world when He rose from the dead, Jesus sent his disciples to share this life with all of creation. *"They went forth and preached everywhere"* (Mk 16:20). The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette minister to people of every race, language, culture and way of life—beginning at the La Salette Shrine in France where our Blessed Mother appeared in 1846. Her final words to the two children (Maximin Melanie), *"well, my children, you will make this known to all my people,"* echo Jesus' Gospel mandate. It is little wonder that the La Salette Congregation has always been mission oriented. When called upon by the Vatican to preach the Gospel in foreign lands, they eagerly responded. This spirit brought them to mission in 27 countries, especially among the poor in Angola, Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Haiti, India, Madagascar, Myanmar, Mozambique, Tanzania and the Philippines. With your cooperation, the Missionaries of La Salette can continue to provide spiritual and financial assistance to these mission countries as they bring God's reconciling message to the poor.



ESTA ES LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD

Hoy celebramos a la Santísima Trinidad, uno de los misterios más confusos de nuestra fe. Por medio de este misterio, experimentamos nuestra relación con Dios: Creador, Salvador y Santificador. Esta relación no es fácil de entender o describir. No se hace más clara por el análisis. Su complejidad refleja la complejidad de todas nuestras relaciones. Entendemos nuestras relaciones con nuestra esposa, nuestros hijos, nuestros padres y nuestros amigos solamente en el día a día, ritos anuales y esos momentos que cambian la vida que compartimos. Entendemos nuestras relaciones al vivir con ellas. Las relaciones que tenemos con los que amamos y con quienes nos aman, nos sustentan por medio de una vida incierta y difícil. Esta es la Santísima Trinidad.

Lo que es sorprendente de las lecturas de hoy es que cada una está incompleta. Lo que ellas ofrecen es una descripción de un momento de nuestra relación, una memoria de un tiempo y un evento donde nuestra relación tiene sentido, aunque ese sentido pueda estar más allá de nuestra habilidad para describirla completamente. Frecuentemente eso es todo lo ofrece nuestra fe, es decir, una memoria de lo que es posible, lo que se promete lo que se ha dado. Una memoria de eternidad, de amor, más allá del entendimiento, debe ser apreciada y nutrida incluso si no es completamente comprendida. Esta es la Santísima Trinidad.

Después de haber traído la plenitud de la vida divina en nuestro mundo cuando El resucito de entre los muertos, Jesús envió a sus discípulos para compartir esta vida con toda la creación: *Ellos salieron a predicar por todas partes* (Mc 16:20). Este espíritu los llevo a la misión en 27 países, especialmente a los pobres en Angola, Argentina, Bolivia, Brasil, Haití, India, Madagascar, Myanmar, Mozambique, Tanzania y Filipinas. Con su cooperación, los Misioneros de La Salette podrán continuar brindando asistencia espiritual y financiera a estos países en misión, llevando el mensaje de reconciliación de Dios a los pobres.
