

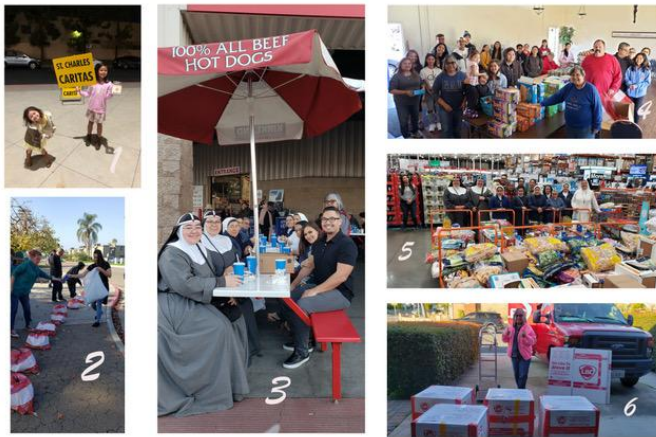
Dear Friends of Saint Charles Caritas,
