She donated for the stove burner/ gas tank and gasket, one month ingredients for this project. Thank you to Mr. Alex Rullan for making this collage of pictures.

Picture 1, the Sisters of Charity in Tijuana received food. Rice, beans and milk are going to the poor people knocking on sisters door asking for food. The Sisters of Charity currently are 13 in the community including the novitiate sisters formation. **Picture 7**, the Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus received a box of pasta and Sister Magnolia Billonia is going to share these with their mission in the island of Cebu to the mentally challenge residing on their House of Mercy. **Pictures, 2 to 6 & 8** a new project by the Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement through Sister Babylyn Dulfo sponsored by Saint Chares Caritas. Mrs. Norly Gane is affiliated with the sisters for the squatter area. Feed the Children project will be cooked by Mrs. Gane and her volunteers 4 times a month on weekends. She will serve food in 4 different areas on the river bank of Paliparan, Phase 5. She has to cook 3 times because she had only one burner. These were prepared inside the squatter vicinity. She does not have much cooking equipment to make it more efficient in cooking but she loved to do it for the sake of these children. The children lined up with a bowl to get the elbow macaroni soup. 140 on the list and not on the list were served soup.
