Pair of slippers and face masks were given to children who do not have one. Thank you to **Mrs. Norly Gane and her team of volunteers**. She also cooked for volunteers rice and vegetables. Thank you to **Mr. Alex Rullan** for always there for the Caritas and making the collage from the start of this mission since 2001.



November 06, 2020, Sunday was the Rosary Class "Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary" week 11. 56 children from ages 3 to 13 attended the class and 7 volunteers assisted from cooking, serving the soup after class and guiding the children. Thank you to two teachers: Ms. Analiza Yauna and Ms. Regina Tesorero. Also, thank you to Mrs. Norly Gane for cooking the soup and lasagna for the volunteers.

Recap: *** The start of the class was the opening prayer: Thanking Saint Charles Caritas donors, praying for the sick: Alexis Cantela, Norma Seibert, prayers for the deceased: Florentino Gonzales & Julino Dulfo and for every prayer intentions of the children. ***The Santo Rosario (Saint Rosary) was lead by the children to sing with actions. ***Q & A was the favorite of the children. It was a competition and the incentives were small pieces of chocolate. ***One of the questions of the teacher: *"What is the purpose that you are here in this class?"*. Majority answered " To know how to pray and share with my family". ***The Rosary Mysteries were emphasized holding the rosary and the teachers went around to make sure which decades they were discussing. ***They also sang the 3 prayers. ***Before the soup was served, the children prayed for the blessings of the food.

On December 20, Sunday the Christmas Event is going to be moved up to December 13 because there was an announcement of lock down for that week.



December 12, 2020, Saturday was the Feed the Children #24. 96 children with tickets were served and many more. 9 volunteers helped. It started with a prayer, leader by children Sophia with Darrell and Tyron. In the video, Sophia thanked the Saint Charles Caritas donors. Children without masks and slippers were given these. Darrell, the 8 year old volunteer will look for children without face masks and slippers and will point out that he or she needs one. Thank you to Mrs. Norly Gane for cooking the soup with chicken, hot dogs, cabbage, carrots, milk and etc. She also cooked for the volunteers beans and chopped pork legs (pata) with coconut milk.

The Christmas Event was moved again to December 20, Sunday. Its been changing because of the proposed lock down.

Recap: *** The class started with prayers, thanking the Saint Charles Caritas, families, children, the world and etc. *** The song for "Awit nang Santo Rosario" (Song of the Saint of the Rosary) was sang with children in action. *** **50 children** can now memorized the 3 prayers: Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be. The Apostle Creed so far only 1 can memorized. She was awarded with 10 snack bars. *** The teachers encouraged the children to memorize these

2 prayers at home including the Hail Holy Queen. *** The teacher also reviewed what decade to say on the day they are going to pray. *** The children's assignment is to memorize the Apostle Creed and Hail Holy Queen and share the prayers to their families.
