August 8, 2021 Sunday was the session for Teach the Children How to Pray in songs: 5 prayers were sang by the children: Our Father, Hail Mary Glory Be to the Father, Salvation Song in Tagalog and Awit sa Ina ng Santo Rosaryo. 33 children attended the session and 6 volunteers. They started at 10am The two teachers who conducted this session: Teacher Regina Tesorero did the opening prayer together with teacher Analiza Yauna. The prayers were thanking the blessings, Saint Charles Caritas,

volunteers, healing of the sick, forgiveness of sins, and the 2 children, Ezekiel and Florimae recited their prayers to stop the pandemic and protect their families, and the people in the world. The Cavite is still in pandemic quarantine. Q & A about the rosary and gave out 10 chocolate snack bars. The childrens assignment to Pray the Rosary at their homes and bring new friends. Childrens food: Chicken noodle soup and bread. The bread donated by teacher Norly Gane. Volunteers food: creamy rigatoni with cheese, leche flan and bread. July 22, 2021, Sunday 10am Rosary Session Reported by teacher Regina Tesorero with teacher Analiza Yauna. 40 children attended, 9 were new attendees (volunteers fetched the children from their homes) and 6

volunteers. "Teacher Analiza did the opening prayer. Then distributed the rosaries to children as we sang the 5 songs with actions: Salvation song Tagalog version, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be to the Father, and Awit sa Ina nang Santo Rosaryo. * A new song was introduced called Hail Mary Gentle Women also with actions. * We did a recap on how to do the correct sign of the cross and think about Jesus Christ, Blessed Mother Mary, Angels and Apostles when praying. We gave all the children chocolates. * The children presented their assignments. They were Sabrina, Kijames, Florimae, Thea, Rejoice.* Assignments: bring new friends, pray the rosary at home, in clean paper to write their parents prayers and wishes for their families. * The food was with blessings prayer by Tyron. * The children and volunteers food was Egg Noodle Soup."

In the videos, the children's request of prayers were to end the covid-19, to help in their hardships, forgiveness of their sins, asking God to help their families and many more. The Sisters from TJ that we are helping regularly before pandemic still cannot cross the border. Only St. Brigit Sisters can.


Caritas schedule for September:

- Every Sunday, the Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary is going on strong. This is located at the Samada Half Court in Phase 5 Paliparan, Cavite
- Once a month, the St. Brigit Sisters will continue to receive food through Costco buy of food. They have 27 Sisters and they have a formation for the Sisters
- The Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will have the Feed the Children depending on the Sisters schedule. The pasta and other food ingredients were shipped but it will take 2 months before they get them. The Sisters will distribute cooked food to the children in the squatter areas of Pasig and Laguna
- The Benedictine Sisters continued to received boxes of pasta and other food for Home Bound Elderly in Paliparan. Shipments of boxes were also done
