

#### November 29, 2021

We have a project called coin operated washer and dryer for the pilgrims of St. Anthony's Guest House in Assisi, Italy. This bed and breakfast guest house is run by the Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement. Currently, the pilgrims of the guest house is using a deep sink to laundry their clothes and hang it on the olive trees with a string in between. The pilgrims who commonly stay at St. Anthony's were priests, nuns, religious brothers, laity and their families. The St. Anthony's Guest House is in need of these washer and dryer. If you would like to earmark your donation, please write in the memo line washer/dryer. Please write in the check payable to Saint Charles Caritas and outside the envelope c/o Merlyn Baker. Please see attached picture of the sister's laundry area for the pilgrims. Sister Babylyn paused in their deep sink laundry area. The price for combo commercial coin operated washer and dryer is \$1,730 dollar conversion to euro is x 1.13 (\$1,730 x 1.13 = \$1,954.90 plus wire transfer of \$45 = \$2,000 round off). These washer and dryer are coin operated to offset the costs of water and electricity.



The St. Anthony's Guest House is located in the center of Assisi. On house right side (about 10 yards) is the San Rufino Cathedral. This is the place where St. Francis and St. Clare were baptized. On their left side about the same distance is the St. Clare Basilica. About 10 to 15 minutes walk, is the St. Francis Basilica and right in a few minutes was the house of the parents of St. Francis. Down the valley is St. Mary Angels Major where St. Francis past away. About 20 minutes walk is San Damiano where St. Clare and her sisters stayed. She past away here. If you are willing to walk further, is the Hermitage of St. Francis, very peaceful place. Also, beloved Carlo Acutis, patron saint of the internet, and many more remarkable history. Assisi is holy and amazingly beautiful.

November 30, Tuesday was Feed the Children #7 by the Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus with Fr. Harvey, Rogationist Father. The Sisters who cooked and distributed the food were: Sr. Magnolia, Sr. Melynde, Sr. Remedios, Sr. Leonor and Sr. Angeline. The Feeding of Children was in Pasig, Philippines squatter area from Tawi-Tawi and San Andres children. 135 children received these pasta and snack bars. Thank you to all who donated for this cause.
