Programs:

*** 1.) "Feed the Children from Ukraine". This will be T-shirts fund raising for \$18 all sizes. 100% of the T-shirt sale proceeds, seed money and any earmark donations for this cause will go to this program. It will be dedicated to Ukraine refugee relief efforts run by the Congregation of Sisters in Poland. These T-shirts will be available on April 23 & 24 (Divine Mercy Sunday), Saturday and Sunday, Caritas Day.

- ***2.) "Feed the Mal-Nourished Children". Under this ministry, we have 10 children that are under-weight (mal-nourished). These children have been attending the prayers for many months now. The program will be to feed the children 6 times a week with milk, Quaker Oats with brown sugar and honey including eggs twice a week. These children were weighed recently before the program begins and be weighed after 2 weeks to see their progress. The aim of this program is to have these children out of mal-nutrition. This is a pilot run program.
- ***3.) "Cell Phones Needed". The two teachers in Paliparan needs 2 cell phones with 64 gigabytes new or used. The purpose: for documentations, for Whats App: texting, video calls meeting, videos, taking pictures and emails for all the sessions for Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary and Feed the Children. Since these are going to be used in international country, please have your donated cell phones be UNLOCKED at your carrier service. If brand new, the estimated costs of 2 cell phones with case, flash drives and connectors are \$576.76 total. Will issue a receipt asap for your donations.
- *April 23 & 24, Saturday and Sunday are the Saint Charles Caritas Day. 100% of your donations will go to buy basic food, some cleaning products and basic necessities to all the charities that we are helping run by nuns. We are all volunteers from San Diego, Mexico and Philippines. After 2:30pm Sunday, we will be buying food at Costco for our 4 religious charities from Mexico.
- *Every Sunday is the Teach the Children How to Pray/Feed the Children in the squatter area of Samada Half Court, Phase 5 Paliparan, Cavite.
- *The Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is scheduled on April 4th to Feed the Children from the squatter areas either Laguna or Pasig.

A note for special project: The Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement in Assisi, Italy has now received the delivery of the washing machine and the coin operated equipment for the pilgrims. The Sisters are now waiting for the technician to install these 2 equipment. After washing your clothes, you still need to hang your laundered clothes in between the olive trees with strings. We will have the picture(s) as soon as the washing machine/coin operated equipment are installed.

If you are vacationing in Rome, you must see Assisi, historical treasure of Italy. The bed and breakfast of St. Anthony's Guest House is run by the Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement, (you can email to atoneasisi@tiscali.it) is very close to the Basilica of St. Clare, San Rufino Cathedral (where both St. Francis, St. Clare and St. Agnes were baptized), The parents house of St. Francis is just a walking distance and St. Clare former house is now attached to San Rufino Cathedral. Down the valley is the Basilica of St. Mary Angels where St. Francis died, San Damiano where St. Clare stayed and died and many more historical sites back in 11th and 12th centuries. Find out and see the historical

museum why Assisi was spared in the bombing during World War II. To see all of these, you must stay at least a week. A lot of pilgrims came back again and again in Assisi. It's a journey that you may personally feel and understand. Many pilgrims, field trips by children from many towns and countries seek to see Assisi. This amazing, serene and heavenly place is just 2 hours by train from Rome.
