The small house where the children for this program is held belongs teacher Regina Tesorero in the squatter area. All are volunteers and thank you. Ms. Regina arranged her house so that the table will fit in. She knows art work decorations as part of her part

time job, decorating for birthdays and weddings called Artsy Regine . God bless you, and All!

If you want to donate Nido milk, vitamins, and food for the children, please let me know.

It is difficult to feel that one of our ministry attendees for Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary is so sick and in dire need of help from all of us. Prince aunt Analiza Yauna one of the 2 volunteer teachers for Pray the Rosary/Feed the Children in Paliparan, Cavite is asking for your help. Please see below her letter in English, Tagalog and Prince picture. Prince needs your prayers of healing, help in kind, and financial donation. If you donate, I will send it as soon as possible to help this child.

### Subject: I'm begging and asking for your help.

My name is Analiza Yauna, **Prince Yuan Altesin**'s aunt, one of the volunteer Teacher of Saint Charles Caritas that teach the children on **How to Pray the Rosary** in SAMADA Phase 5 Brgy. Paliparan 3 Dasmariñas City Cavite. I am knocking on your door and heart for my nephew's needs for medication and admission in the hospital. He's name is Prince Yuan Y. Altesin, 5 years old. He is one of the children that attends the session every Sundays to Pray the Rosary. He has this health condition of

Enlargement of stomach, Edema (whole body), Stomach ache, 4 days before he release his toxic waste not a normal one, and Malnourished.

We don't have money to pay for all the expenses like medications and hospital admission. The parents of the child has no permanent work. His mother's name is Anabelle Yauna who is my sister and she is a housewife while her husband name is Francis Altesin, is a construction worker who do part time only and the salary is not enough to sustain the needs and hospital admission. We tried to admit the child last May 04, 2022 because we cannot bear to see the child in so much pain and the people tried to refer us to some public hospitals in Cavite and Manila but the hospital kept rejecting us because there was no vacancy anymore. One of the hospital in Manila tried to assist us further but the hospital needs us to undergo swab/rapid test before admitting but we don't have enough money to do the test because it was so much expensive but they do have other option to admit and that was putting the child inside the area wherein there are a lot of COVID patients (isolated area) but of course we don't approved that we cannot risk the child just for that, that was why we just went home and tried some alternatives at home. Prince still needs medication for his fast recovery but we hope that he can be admitted to a hospital since we cannot control the enlargement of his stomach. The whole family is praying for our nephew's fast recovery and we want to see him smile, active and attend the rosary again. We are knocking on your heart for some help and prayers we really appreciate anything that you can help. Thank you so much and God bless you all.

The food will be expanded next shipments on the way with peanut butter and jams, bread, pasta, pancake with corn syrup and rice. It will be given in alternating menu daily. The goal is for the children to get out from malnutrition and hopefully will graduate within a month. Once, the children graduates, another children who are malnourished will be registered. Let me know if you want to donate food and vitamins for these children. The volunteers were Cresencia and ReginaTesorero, Ruffa Oraye and Analiza Yauna. This program is held in the Tesorero small house. The Tesorero's volunteered their house for this program. **God bless you and thank you.** 

**05/07/22**, was Feed the Children in collaboration with the Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus week 12 in their convent (38 children) and Floodway (60 children) in Pasig. Notebooks, Rosary/Guide How to Pray the Rosary, Divine Mercy pamphlets, spaghetti and Swiss Cocoa mix were distributed. Thank you to Sister Magnolia Billona and Sisters.

- May 2, Monday started the Feed the Malnourished Children from Pray the Rosary session. 11 children are listed to participate on this program. The goal is to get the children out of malnutrition. The children currently are under weight. From Monday to Saturday currently, these children are feed with Quaker Oats, Milk, Honey, Brown Sugar and twice a week with boiled eggs for a month. Once the children are over their clinical weights of more than 10 kgs each, then a child can graduate and another child that is malnourished will come in into the program.
- The Feed the Children both in Pasig and Laguna schedules run by the Sister Magnolia Billona, Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be announced later. Currently, the Sisters have a canonical visits from Italian Sisters. Feed the Children done on May 7, 2022.

Please see attached a collage of events this April. *Picture 1*, Costco buy of Food for the 4 religious charity congregations from Tijuana, Mexico. *Pictures 2 to 7* the two teachers: Regina Tesorero and Analiza Yauna received the food items for Rosary/ Malnourished Children. *Picture 8*, 3 LBC shipments, 1 for Feed the Children run by the Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and 2 for the Feed the Children/some food gifts for volunteers who also live in the squatter areas. These shipments approximately will be received for about 2 months.



## Feed the Malnourished pilot program week 2 (05/09 to 05/14/2022).

Daily breakfasts (Quaker oatmeal with brown sugar/honey, eggs, quick mix and milk) were served daily for 6 days. The goal is to get these children out from malnutrition at least gain weight above the clinical weight based on each child's age. We hope in a month some children will graduate. After the child graduated from the program, another malnourished child will join the program.

We are concern that one of the children is in the hospital right now. Please pray for Prince Yuana Altesin. The laboratory test results yesterday that Prince has enlargement of the heart and kidney problem. It is abnormal for his age (5 years old) to have a large heart. The doctor recommends a 2D

Echo laboratory. Prince is still in the hospital with dextrose and oxygen hooked up on him. The family is very poor. Parents do not have work. Living in the family of his auntie's rented house of 9 family members (Analiza is the Sunday teacher volunteer to Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary). The auntie Analiza has been in contact with me for the update of Prince condition. I thank God for you for helping Prince. Prince needs financial help. Please, please pray for the healing of Prince.

Below I am presenting a translation of thanks for the sacrifice for refugees from Ukraine in Poland - in the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy.

### Jesus, I trust you

On behalf of all refugees from Ukraine who are staying in the religious houses of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland, as well as on behalf of the Mother General and the sisters of our Congregation, we would like to thank you for your donation in the amount of USD 5,028.00 (five thousand twenty-eight dollars USA), which was deposited into our bank account on 05/18/2022.

We would like to share that currently there are 160 refugees in our homes, and in total, temporarily and now, more than 200 people have lived. Our monasteries in Poland are primarily women - mothers and sometimes mothers and grandmothers with children. They are provided with accommodation and meals. The state made it possible for refugees to receive treatment on the same terms as Poles, as well as other services supporting their stay. Children go to kindergartens and schools. In our 3 kindergartens, 20 children who live in the neighborhood are looked after per day. Currently, some young people in Poland pass their secondary school exams. Women would very much like to work in order to have something to do and spend their time. They are very calm and good guests. Grateful for everything!

Therefore, please accept the heartfelt thanks and pass it on to ALL who in any way contributed to the sacrifice sent to us, and which will be divided and sent to specific places of refugees and well used.

May Merciful Jesus bless the Donors who have split up with the Ukrainian people with their hearts and financial support.

Kobiety bardzo chciałyby pracować, aby mieć zajęcie i zagospodarowac czas. Są to bardzo spokojni i dobrzy nasi Goście. Wdzięczni za wszystko!

The Feed the Malnourished program is now in week 3. For the past weeks from Monday to Saturday breakfasts, the children were served with Quaker Oats with milk, brown sugar & honey, and boiled eggs (Nido milk, Pedia Sure). Some of the children are a little bit gaining weight but not much. The feeding is in the small house of Tesorero family in the squatter area. Prayers were done before and after breakfast by alternating children and by teacher Regina. Thank you to 3 volunteers: Cresencia & Regina Tesorero and Ruffa Oraye. The children ages from 8 months old to 12 years old. 10 children total. If you want to donate for these malnourished children in kind or monetary gifts, we can buy these children foods and vitamins.

Prince Yauna Altesin, a 5 year old boy has been absent from the malnourished program because has been sick. The family is very poor also resides in the squatter area. With the helped of 7 benefactors, paid for his doctor's 2d echo test and other check ups. Because in the Philippines, if you do not have money, more likely you will not be

admitted in the hospital or clinic to see a doctor. The family hasn't gotten the hospital bills yet. Prince results are water in the heart and blood infection and is referred by the doctor to the Philippine Heart Center in Manila yesterday. Please, please pray for Prince healing. It is in God's hands.

He is fine now, No blood infection anymore his kidney are all treated and his **valvular heart disease** is still on going.

After 2-3 days of observation, they will go to Philippine Heart Center (PHC) to check him up and have a record since the assigned physician advised the parents that prince condition is needing a surgery. So they have to transfer him to PHC for further assistance and treatment. The doctor gave Prince the maintenance drug that the parents need to buy for his heart. He is so excited to be discharged" from Analiza Yauna, one of the Teachers volunteer for Teach the Children How to Pray/Feed the Children

I believe God has been watching Prince because the first diagnosis were kidney problem, blood infection and then heart problem. The first two problems were gone. We
