Please pray for the fast healing of Prince Yauna Altesin, a 5 year old boy from Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary and Feed the Malnourished programs who has heart problem and need operation according to his doctor. He is referred to the Philippine Heart Center (PHC). I just received a text from his Auntie Analiza (teacher volunteer for Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary/Feed the Children) and the doctor in PHC said, Prince need blood laboratory cost in pesos 1700 = \$32.69, X-ray, 2D Echo cost 800 = \$15.38 and consultation 200 = \$3.84. These are discounted. A total of \$55.75. The parents requested to come back next week because for they have money only for X-Ray and consultation. Prince has to come back for other lab tests. Prince needs your prayers and help.

"Prince's Update as of 06/08/2022: Good morning. Prince is good now a days, since he is taking antibiotics for 10 days he has this cough, and sneeze effect and fever sometimes. But overall he still active and fine. He is taking his maintenance regularly and his physician informed my sister that the schedule for 2d Echo in Philippine Heart Center would be on August since the slot for June and July are already taken. And this check up, follow up observation and medications are until 6 months. The doctor will observe prince if his diagnosis really requires operation or it will be resolved by using medications.
