WHY THE CHURCH OPPOSES PROPOSITION 1

This year in California, we are called in a very specific way to reject the pathway of making illegal virtually all limitations on abortion. Proposition 1, which would enshrine in the state constitution the ability to have late-term abortions and abortions for purposes of gender selection, as well as allowing subsidies for abortion for people who do not even live in California, is absolutely incompatible with the Gospel call to protect all human life. And we must witness to that contradiction in our role as citizens.

The very excruciating issue of abortion calls us to balance the challenging problems of women who are pregnant with the lives of unborn children. Proposition 1 simply obliterates the moral reality of the unborn child in striking this balance. As people of faith, we must not accept such a logic.

Instead, we must work within our society to build a comprehensive framework that genuinely protects and builds the dignity and sacredness of human life in its fullness, at every stage and for every person. Only if our state's voters reject Proposition 1 can we meaningfully proceed toward this goal in California. And that must begin with us.

Daily Prayer For Priests

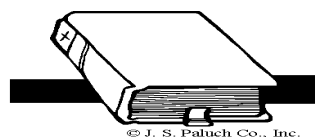

New Synod Phase Begins

The initial listening phase of the diocese's historic consultation of the faithful has ended. Over 22,000 completed an electronic survey that closed Oct. 31, and more than 11,000 attended small-group sessions at parishes, schools and other sites earlier this year in San Diego and Imperial Counties. They shared their experiences and hopes for the Church.

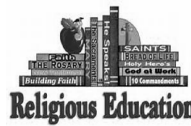
The discernment phase begins now. Commission members, mostly lay leaders, will analyze the data to develop proposals to address the major concerns expressed by the faithful. These will be submitted to Cardinal Robert McElroy, who plans to begin to implement them early next year, in consultation with the diocese's pastors.

This consultation is part of a worldwide journey the Catholic Church began in October of 2021. The synod, as it's called, was scheduled to end next fall but Pope Francis has extended it to 2024 to allow more time for reflection and discernment from both the local and universal Church. The goal of the synod is to renew the Church by increasing participation at all levels, particularly by young people. This would be achieved by fostering a "synodal" culture where the faithful and hierarchy work together to discern what God is calling the Church to do at this crucial time. 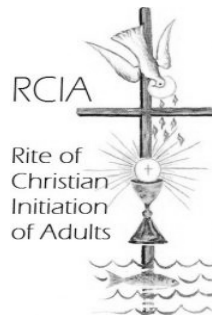

POR QUE LA IGLESIA SE OPONE A LA PROPOSICION 1

Este año en California, somos llamados de una manera muy específica a rechazar el camino que lleve a hacer ilegal casi toda limitación en contra del aborto. La Proposición 1 protegería en la constitución estatal la posibilidad de tener abortos en el tercer trimestre y abortos con el fin de seleccionar el género del bebe, así como también pagar por el aborto por personas que ni siquiera viven en California. Estas acciones absolutamente contradicen el llamado del Evangelio de proteger toda la vida humana. Como ciudadanos no podemos permitir esta contradicción.

Comienza Nueva Fase del Sinodo

La fase inicial de la histórica consulta diocesana a los feligreses, la cual consistía en escuchar, ha terminado. Mas 22 mil personas completaron la encuesta electrónica que se cerró el 31 de octubre y alrededor de 11 mil personas participaron en las sesiones de grupos pequeños que se realizaron en parroquias, escuelas y otros sitios a principios de este año en los Condados de San Diego e Imperial. En esta fase, los participantes compartieron sus experiencias y esperanzas para la Iglesia.

Ahora comienza la fase de discernimiento. Miembros de una comisión, la mayoría de ellos líderes laicos, analizarán la información recabada para desarrollar propuestas y de esta manera abordar las principales preocupaciones expresadas por los fieles. Estas propuestas serán entregadas al cardenal Robert McElroy, quien planea comenzar a implementarlas a principios del próximo año, en conjunto con los parrocos.

Esta consulta forma parte de una iniciativa mundial que la Iglesia Católica comenzó en octubre de 2021. El sinodo, como se le llama, estaba programado para terminar el próximo otoño, pero el Papa Francisco lo ha extendido hasta el año 2024 para permitir más tiempo de reflexión y discernimiento tanto en la Iglesia local como universal. La meta del sinodo es renovar la Iglesia por medio de una mayor participación en todos los niveles, particularmente de gente joven.

Esto se lograría fomentando una cultura "sinodal" donde los fieles y la jerarquía trabajen de la mano para discernir lo que Dios está llamando a la Iglesia a hacer en este momento crítico de su historia. Más información disponible en español en la página web sdcatholic.org/sinodo.

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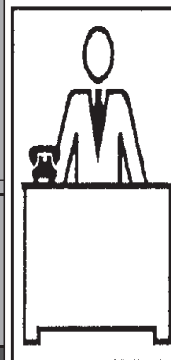
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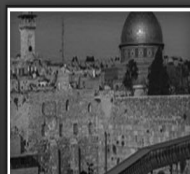
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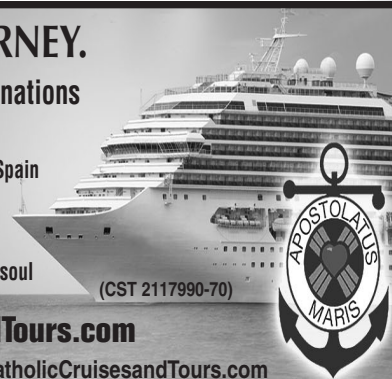
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
