Last month of September, the Saint Charles Caritas was visited by **Sister Babylyn Dulfo from Franciscan Sisters of the Atonement**. Sister Babylyn was instrumental to start the Feed the Children, then Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary in Paliparan squatter area in Cavite. This ministry started during pandemic time in 2019. She had surveyed this Paliparan sites before and mentioned to Caritas the great need in this area.

While she was in San Diego, she experienced the cycle of the Saint Charles Caritas processes. From buying the food to fill in the LBC box and picked up of boxes in the garage for Philippines 3 charities. She had joined the choir for the Feast of San Lorenzo Ruiz (first Filipino Saint), also joined the 2 Sundays 7:00 am choir and masses. She volunteered for the Saturday (1 mass) and Sunday (6 masses) Caritas Day and the buying of food for the 4 different Sisters congregation charities from Tijuana, Mexico at Costco, San Diego. What God blessings to have her in San Diego and participated with Saint Charles Church/Caritas activities! Come back again, Sister Babylyn and God bless you always!!!

Both in Mexico and Philippines got these donations and more to be shipped.

### ***Caritas Schedule:***

- **Caritas Days in October 15 (Saturday) and 16 (Sunday).** 100% of your donations will be used to buy basic food and basic necessities for our charities that we are helping. These charities are run by religious Sisters and Priest. We are all volunteers. Zero overhead costs and No administrative layers. You are helping an orphanage, home for girls, home for the elderly, contemplative sisters, teach the children how to pray the rosary/ feed the children, and poor children learning catechism.
- **Every Sunday is the Teach the Children How to Pray the Rosary/Feed the Children in the squatter area in Paliparan, Cavite.** The teachers are Analiza Yauna and Regina Tesorero
- **The Hospitaller Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus ministry is also Feed the Children in the squatter areas of Pasig such as Tawi-tawi and San Andres and etc.** Sister Magnolia will announce when they can feed the children when she comes back from Italy this October.

- **Canossian Sons of Charity ministry by Fr. Jeephy Simbajon with the seminarians apostolate activities for children catechism.** The Saint Charles Caritas will be sending boxes of food, notebooks, pencils, pens and etc for the children. This place is one of the Philippines islands in Cagayan de Oro, Misamis Oriental.
- **Baptism Ministry:** These October and November in Paliparan Sites 1 to 5, will start again to be scouting door to door poor families who would like to be baptized. Last April 10, 2020, we were able to have 106 baptized children and adults.
- **Blessed Mother of Perpetual Help statue.** The chapel in Siargao island, Philippines is requesting a statue of the Blessed Mother Mary. We have a donor who is going to donate the statue to be purchased in the Philippines.
- **Guitar with a hard case.** A religious Sister is requesting a guitar with hard case. If you have one, please let me know.

There will be no Caritas Day in December as we always do not have it every year. But if you want to donate, you can mail your donation and or drop it off at the church office. We are still going to purchase food for the charities from Mexico and food boxes for the charities in the Philippines for December.

Jeephy, seminarians and children were thanking the Saint Charles Caritas. The estimated travel of these items are 75 days before reaching the Canossian Brothers.
