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Recap for the Saint Charles Caritas Ministry Mission in the Philippines from June 4 to August 8, 2026 giving Jollibee Meals with drinks and other cooked meals. Since the children's classes started in June, we have to wait mostly for Saturdays and Sundays to distribute the meals and school supplies. The children are always thankful for your love and generosity. Thank you so much kind hearted people.

- 300 children in Barangay Consolacion, 7 districts
- 120 children in Barangay 26, Osmena Extension 1 & 2
- 80 children in Paliparan, Cavite children
- 85 children Child Development Centers, San Juan 2 and Lapaz 1
- 138 children in Barangay Carmen
- 136 children in San Lazaro Chapel
- 30 children/staff in Calabrian Children's Foundation, home for girls and home for boys
- 180 children and etc... in San Roque neighborhood
- **Total 1,069 children recipients**

542++ school supplies were given to children

On the 2 months that I was in the Philippines for the charity mission, Sister Babylyn and I experienced the extreme heat/humidity, raining for several weeks, flooding, thunder storms, earthquakes, and some barangay houses were on fire. Many families were displaced. But with all of this natural catastrophe, we were able to served Jollibee meals/our cooked food and school supplies to the poor children.

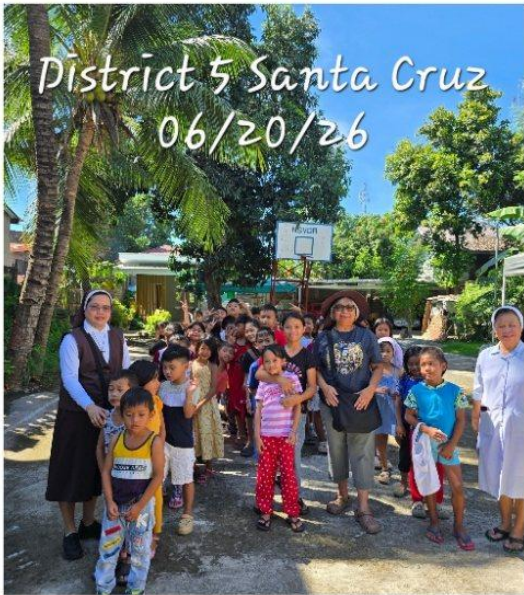
The transportation going to these mission places were quite difficult because of the alleys' narrow path, and taxis' were hesitant to drive inside these locations. We had to unload the food and place it on a manual tricycle while I was holding tight on the rusty railing of the tricycle to make sure I will not fall. 😊

I salute with admiration the hard work of religious missionaries on the field who do daily missionary tasks. Indeed it was hard work, but very fulfilling. Yes, we do it for God!!!

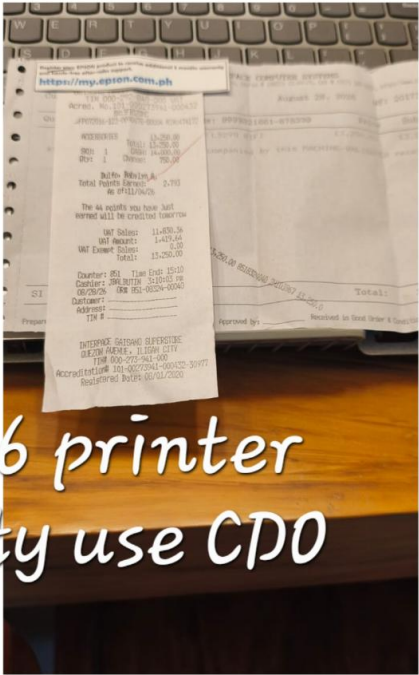
